Svein Andresen is the Secretary General of the Financial Stability Forum (FSF). Prior to this, he held various positions at the Bank for International Settlements (BIS). He was Advisor to the General Manager of the BIS from 1997 to 2000, and lead the secretariat to G10 central bank governors on financial issues from 1995 through 1997. He was Secretary to the Committee on the Global Financial System (CGFS) from 1992 till 1997. Prior to joining the BIS, Mr. Andresen was an assistant professor of economics at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He has a Masters degree in economics from Simon Fraser University in British Columbia, Canada, and a PhD from the Graduate Institute of International Studies in Geneva, Switzerland.
