András Fekete-Győr became the Deputy Managing Director of the National Deposit Insurance Fund (NDIF) of Hungary in 1993, following his work to establish the fund. The NDIF was the first deposit insurance system to be established in Eastern Europe. Dr. Fekete-Győr's responsibilities include resolution management of failed banks, asset management issues, PR activities, accounting and finance as well as investment operations of the fund.

Before Dr. Fekete-Győr's work at the NDIF, he was the Managing Director of the Chief Representative Office for Eastern Europe of *Pilar Management*, a conglomerate of companies active in insurance as well as in merchant and commercial banking. In this position he was responsible for formulating investment strategies in Eastern Europe.

Dr. Fekete-Győr also had served as the General Manager and Head of International Banking Relations for *Unicbank Rt.*, Senior Manager of the International Monetary Department of the *National Bank of Hungary*, and Import Manager of *Monimpex Trading Co Ltd.*

Dr. Fekete-Győr received his doctorate and masters degrees from the Economics University of Budapest.
