Mr. Mutsuo Hatano became the Deputy Governor of Deposit Insurance Corporation of Japan (DICJ) when he joined the DICJ in September 2005. He has been responsible mainly for the areas of finance and international affairs at the DICJ since then. Before joining the DICJ, Mr. Hatano was the Deputy Chairman of Nippon Export and Investment Insurance. He managed that export credit agency to extend international trade and investment insurance in Japan.

Mr. Hatano began his career when he joined the Bank of Tokyo. He then accumulated his rich experience and intensive expertise in international finance and capital markets financing while engaged in the banking business.

Since 2005, Mr. Hatano has been an active member of IADI's Executive Council. In February 2008, he became the Vice Chair of the Council. He is also the Chair of Asia Regional Committee and the Acting Chair of Finance and Planning Committee.

Mr. Hatano graduated from Faculty of Law of the University of Tokyo and he completed the Advanced Management Program (AMP) of Harvard Business School.
