Mr. Iannicola is the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Financial Education at the U.S. Department of the Treasury in Washington, D.C. In this role, he oversees the Office of Financial Education which supports the expansion and improvement of financial education across the country. These activities have included testifying before Congress, publishing the first ever national strategy on financial literacy and advising companies, schools, non-profits and state and local governments on financial education strategies. Additionally, Mr. Iannicola was recently named Executive Director of the President's Advisory Council on Financial Literacy.

Before joining Treasury, Mr. Iannicola acquired an extensive background in education including roles as a school board president, adjunct professor of business law and an official at the U.S. Department of Education. His first career however, was practicing law. For eight years prior to joining the government, Mr. Iannicola was an attorney in the financial services industry. He is a native of St. Louis, Missouri and a graduate of the Wharton School of Business, the University of Illinois College Of Law, and the American University Graduate School of Communications.
