Carlos Isoard has served as Member of the Governing Board of the *Instituto para la Protección al Ahorro Bancario* (IPAB), Mexico, since May 1999. Before joining IPAB he worked for the *Banco de México* (Central Bank) since 1972 in several capacities, the last one as General Director of the Commercial Development Trust Fund (1991-1999). He was also member of the Board, or Board Committees of government banks, trusts and other public institutions as representative of *Banco de México* (1989-1999).

Mr. Isoard is the Chair of the Latin America Regional Committee of the International Association of Deposit Insurers (IADI) since 2002 and was a member of the Working Group on Deposit Insurance of the Financial Stability Forum (1999-2002). He holds a MA degree in Economics from the University of Chicago (1977) and a BA in the same field from ITAM (*Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México*) (1974). Since December 2006 he is Member of the Advisory Council of the School of Economics of the *Universidad Panamericana*, where he taught from 1978 to 2003. He also taught at ITAM in 1977.
