Two New Deposit Insurance Publications Available in Spanish

The Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) has announced that its two new deposit insurance brochures for bank customers made available in April 2004 – *Insuring Your Deposits* (FDIC-016-2004) and *Your Insured Deposits-FDIC's Guide to Deposit Insurance Coverage* (FDIC-015-2004) – are now available in Spanish language versions.

Seguro Para Sus Depósitos is the Spanish language version of *Insuring Your Deposits*. This publication is a basic explanation of federal deposit insurance coverage rules for deposit accounts most commonly owned by individuals and families. *Sus Depósitos Asegurados* is the Spanish language version of *Your Insured Deposits-FDIC's Guide to Deposit Insurance Coverage*. This is an updated version of the FDIC's 1999 comprehensive publication of the same name, which is intended for depositors who need more detailed information about the FDIC's deposit insurance rules.
