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We will develop an additional 23 single-family homes within the next 24 months. These developments have construction loan commitments from local banks totaling \$1,681,000.00

The proposed rule change will reduce the current number of FDIC regulated institutions required to comply with the present Community Reinvestment Act from sixty-three institutions to eleven institutions in Missouri.

The rule change will undermine current public and private sector investment in rural America and result in a negative impact on our future housing development.

Please do not adopt this rule.
