If these accounts are not given full coverage, many lawyers will feel compelled to convert their trust and escrow IOLTA accounts to straight non-interest-bearing transactional accounts, and this will result in a severe loss of funding for our program and a corresponding drastic cut in legal services to the poor, whose need for such services is greater in this economic downturn.
