We wish to voice our concern over this decision to assess all banks the same across the board for the sins of few. We realize we must maintain reserves and the FDIC must remain solvent for the benefit of the banking system, however, the costs of insurance should be greater for those banks who offer more risk to the system including this emergency assessment.
