Our Bank currently uses one general ledger account each for reporting Overdraft and Account Maintenance charges, regardless of whether the account is Business or Personal.

To comply with the proposed change to the **Schedule RI** Line **M15** detail for June 30, 2013, we would have to create two new sets of general ledger accounts, and re-code all of our Deposit subsystems to identify which of the two general ledger accounts (Business or Personal) each account should be associated with.

I believe the current implementation timeframe (June 30, 2013) would cause undue hardship on our Bank; therefore, I would like consideration be given to postponing this proposed change.
