Deposit Insurance Coverage – Comprehensive Training Free Nationwide Seminars for Bank Officers and Employees

Summary: The FDIC will conduct ten identical telephone seminars for bank officers and employees that will provide comprehensive training on deposit insurance coverage rules and regulations. Each seminar will begin with an audio and slide presentation, immediately followed by a question-and-answer period with FDIC subject matter experts. The seminars will be conducted between March 23 and December 7, 2011, and are free to employees and officers of FDIC-insured banks and savings associations.

- Bank employees and officials may participate in any of the ten seminars. Participation in the seminars is voluntary.

The FDIC is offering ten free telephone seminars on deposit insurance coverage rules and regulations. The objective is to provide bank employees and officers with comprehensive guidance on the FDIC's deposit insurance rules so they can assist depositors in determining insurance coverage. Participation in the seminars is strictly voluntary and open to employees and officials of all FDIC-insured banks and saving associations.

Each seminar will begin with an approximately 120-minute audio presentation linked to a slide presentation that can be downloaded from the FDIC's Web site at <http://www.fdic.gov/news/news/financial/2011/fil11014a.html>. A question-and-answer period with FDIC subject matter experts will follow. Each seminar will provide a comprehensive overview of the FDIC's deposit insurance rules, including important changes enacted in 2010 and in 2011. The seminars are ideal for any bank employee or official interested in developing a comprehensive understanding of FDIC deposit insurance rules.

The procedures for registering for each seminar and accessing the seminar slide presentation follow.

Registering for Deposit Insurance Coverage Seminars

Seminar participants must register at least two business days before the event by following these procedures:

1. Go to www.mymeetings.com/rsvp.
2. Enter the conference number for the specific seminar, as detailed below.
3. Enter **5713188** for the pass code.
4. Leave the PIN number blank.
5. Click on the “Proceed” button.
6. On the next page, provide name and e-mail address, then click the “Proceed” button. No additional information is needed.

At the conclusion of this registration process, the participant should receive an RSVP e-mail confirmation, along with the PIN that is required to join the teleconference on the date selected. If an e-mail confirmation is not received, the participant should recheck the e-mail address provided and repeat the registration process. **Please note that any number of bank employees may join the participant who has registered for the call.**

Accessing the Slide Presentation

The slide presentation for each seminar is available on the FDIC's Web site. Participants are strongly encouraged to have a copy of the slides with them during the FDIC staff presentation.

The seminar is not a Webinar that automatically transitions between slides. To view the slide presentation, a participant must either (1) log on to one of the FDIC Web site links below and follow the presenter's instruction to move to the next slide or (2) print a hardcopy of the presentation and follow the presenter's instruction to move to the next slide.
