My name is Elizabeth McGeever and I am an attorney in Wilmington, Delaware. I currently serve as a chair of the Combined Campaign for Justice. The Campaign raises funds to support three agencies in Delaware that provide legal services to the poor. The funds raised by the Campaign from the private bar supplement the funds provided by Delaware's Interest on Lawyers' Trust Accounts (IOLTA) program.

In connection with the new Temporary Liquidity Guarantee Program, I write to urge that the FDIC support full coverage for IOLTA accounts, regardless of dollar amount. This is critical because of the need to preserve and enhance IOLTA accounts. Simply put, now is not the time to force lawyers to abandon IOLTA programs that provide desperately needed revenue for legal aid for the poor given (1) the increased demand in legal services for the poor and (2) the difficulty in the current economic climate to raise funds for legal service programs.
