SUBJECT: Meeting with Representatives from Better Markets

On August 24, 2016, staff from the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC), Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC), the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (FRB), the Federal Housing Finance Agency (FHFA), and the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) met with representatives from Better Markets. The Better Markets representatives shared their views on the second joint Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPR) to implement section 956 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. This NPR was published in the Federal Register on June 10, 2016 (81 FR 37670). Specifically, they discussed the application of clawback, the length of the vesting period, cliff vesting, limitations on the use of stock options, and restrictions on personal hedging.
