SUBJECT: Meeting with Representatives from Public Citizen and AFL-CIO

On June 12, 2023, staff from the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) met with representatives from Public Citizen and the AFL-CIO. The meeting was held by video call.

The representatives from these organizations shared their views of the second joint Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPR) to implement section 956 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. This NPR was published in the Federal Register on June 10, 2016 (81 FR 37670). The representatives suggested provisions that should be included in a final rule. Specifically, the representatives discussed a prohibition on stock options and hedging, and recommended an approach for deferral.
