On March 2, 2021, staff from the Office of the Comptroller of the Currency (OCC), Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System (FRB), and Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) held a virtual meeting with representatives from the Financial Services Sector Coordinating Council (FSSCC). The FSSCC representatives shared their views on a notice of proposed rulemaking published in the *Federal Register* by the OCC, FRB, and FDIC on January 12, 2021 (86 Fed. Reg. 2,299).
