## Opposition and/or Concern Regarding CRA Changes

Dear Mr. Feldman,

Greenlining Institute is one of the nation's largest community reinvestment multiethnic coalitions and one of the two largest in California.

In general, we applaud you for resisting the OTS anti-consumer, "See No Evil" approach to CRA exams and reporting. However, we remain concerned about the nature of your analysis and disclosure regarding banks with between \$250 million to \$1 billion in assets.

One of our greatest concerns is the discretionary role of investments in communities. Investments, often far more than lending, are the key to revitalizing low-income communities.

Regarding the deletion of a separate test for services, we are concerned that this will reduce incentives for building bank branches in low-income communities, despite the fact that a growing number of multi-billion dollar banks have recognized the need for and profitability of bank branches in low-income communities.

Regarding the proposed elimination of public data disclosure requirements relating to community development and small business lending, we are perplexed as to why mid-size banks, which are vital in many communities, should be excluded from public data disclosure.
