I have worked with people with disabilities for 30 years. As Director (currently retired) of a program for people with disabilities at the University of New Orleans, I was over a self-employment training program, where the participants received intensive business training from UNO college of Business and community business leaders. Upon successful completion, they could receive up to \$20,000 start-up money from La. Rehabilitation Services. Many would not qualify for loans from banking institutions. The program assisted many individuals successfully start a business and get off dependence on a Disability check. I support the Community Reinvestment Act regulations to assist low to moderate income taxpayers, who have disabilities, so they can qualify for loans and investments that would help them since so many are unbanked and have no place to ask for loans for their businesses.
