Summary: Staffs of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, Federal Reserve System, and Office of the Comptroller of the Currency met with representatives from Investment Company Institute ("ICI"), BlackRock, Nuveen, State Street, JP Morgan, Franklin Financial, PIMCO, Morgan Stanley, BNY Mellon, and Debevoise & Plimpton LLP (collectively, the "ICI representatives") regarding the agencies' Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on Regulatory Capital Rule: Large Banking Organizations and Banking Organizations With Significant Trading Activity (FDIC RIN 3064–AF29) (the "NPR"), which was published in the Federal Register on September 18, 2023 (88 FR 64028). The ICI representatives discussed the NPR's impact on investment companies, regulated funds, defined contribution plans, and investment advisers, as described in their comment letters.
